PARTICIPATION

All national representations, affiliated to International Judo Federation (I.J.F), can participate. Each country will be able to register up to 4 competitors per weight category.

The cost will be **USD 20** for each participant, paying it at the moment of the registration.

Female: -48 Kg., -52 Kg., -57 Kg., -63 Kg., -70 Kg., -78 Kg. y +78 kg. Male: -60 Kg., -66 Kg., -73 Kg., -81 Kg., -90 Kg., -100 kg. y +100 kg.

SYSTEM OF COMPETENCES

The tournament will be held according to the statutes and regulations of the I.J.F.

ENROLMENT

First registration (NUMERICAL)

FRIDAY 123RD JANUARY (deadline for the reception of the form by F.U.J)

Final registration (NOMINAL) Rooms reservation and flight information FRIDAY 27TH FEBRUARY (deadline for the reception of forms by F.U.J)

We won't be receiving registrations after February 27, 2015.

The enrolment to the tournament is submitted to the statutes and regulations of the executive committee who reserves the right to suspend or cancel the Montevideo Open 2015.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Organizing Committee will provide emergency medical coverage to all participants, officially registered by their National Federation. This coverage is for first aid during competition / training and transport until the participant gets medical care from his/her medical centre or gets coverage from his/her health insurance.

In case of extraordinary medical care such as accidents, injury and / or illness requiring hospitalization, treatments, surgeries and drugs required, the costs shall be borne by the National Federation the competitor represents. Therefore the participating federations will exempt the Organizing Committee and Uruguayan Judo Federation of responsibility for any mishap occurred in the competition / training. Each National Federation is responsible for their own competitors. Sex control is responsibility of each National Federation, and fully responsibility must be assumed.



Each Federation assumes full civil responsibility for their competitors and officials. Judo Uruguayan Federation and the Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any claims, injuries or death.

In the case of interposed legal proceedings, quasi-legal, or administrative regulatory proceeding in which a National Federation member and / or the Pan-American Judo Confederation should be required to spend money to defend itself and / or Judo sport, the National Federation member shall support any and all liability to indemnify and exonerate the Pan American Judo Confederation and the Uruguayan Judo Federation against any legal action, costs and implications that could occur as a result of a legal action.

OFFICIAL HOTEL

Hotel Dazzler Montevideo 4 stars Single Room USD 220 (american dollars) Double USD 160 (american dollars) Triple Room USD 135 (american dollars)

The rates are per person and per night and include the following:

- Accommodation
- Meals (breakfast, lunch y dinner)
- Airport transfers Hotel Airport
- Hotel transfers Event Hotel

Hotel:

Triple room depends on availability Minimum 3 nights per participant.

Once the booking has been done the Delegation that miss the event must pay the costs of the booking. Because of that when doing the booking each delegation have to provide a credit card number as warranty.

In case of injury of any athlete, the reservation may be canceled 72 hours before the arrival date in order to avoid a penalty of one night's accommodation.

At the time of check-in must present a passport.



AIRPORT TRANSFER

The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any transfers if the information and flight schedules is not sent before February 27, 2015 or if it suffers any modifications without notifying the Organizing Committee 24 hours before the deadline.

The transfers to the airport will be in sync with schedule sent by each delegation.

The transfers are exclusively for the delegations and it does not include any independent transfers.

Taking into the count that the delegations can leave in different times, they will have two instances for the transfers from the hotel to the aiport.

In case of entering the country via sea (Fluvio Maritime Terminal Port of Montevideo) or by bus ("Tres Cruces" bus station) the delegations have to inform it at the moment of asking for the service.

All payments must be in cash (american dollars bills) at the moment of the registration. Banking transfers, credit card or checks won't be accepted.

The Judo Uruguayan Federation and the Organizing Committee will not be responsible for the availability, any accommodation changes or meals if the deadline for the reception of forms by F.U.J for the Final registration (NOMINAL) Rooms reservation and flight information for each delegation is not accomplished (FEBRUARY, FRIDAY 27TH, 2015).

The Judo Uruguayan Federation and the Organizing Committee will not warranty any rates and accommodation booking outside the deadlines mentioned in this document.

The countries delegations that don't accept the accommodations options that the Organizing Committee is offering, they won't be able to have any transfers or meals services during the time they are in the country and each delegation will have to pay USD 200 (american dollars) per person as a right of participation.

ACCREDITATION

The head of delegation of each country should be in time to certify the arrival of all athletes and delegates and shall provide passports thereof. Participants not registered in time wont be allowed to participate in the tournament.

ANTHEMS AND FLAGS

All Federations must provide with the flag of their country $(1.20 \times 1.80 \text{ m})$ and a CD containing the corresponding National Anthem. (a short version).

The Judo Uruguayan Federation and the Organizing Committee will not be responsible for the lack of it at the time of awards.



COMPETITION RULES

The competition was developed in accordance with the arbitration rules IJF Men: 5 minutes and Golden Score no time limit

Ladies: 4 minutes and Golden Score no time limit

The playoffs will be quarterfinals

DRAW

Two persons per delegation will be allowed to witness the draw. Clothing: suit: jacket and tie.

AWARDS

Each participant who win a medal should attend to the respective awards ceremony. An unjustified absence will be enough to lose the rights to get the medal.

JUDOGUIS

It will be compulsory a blue and a white judoguis per competitor.

Judoguis control is done through rules adopted by the IJF Sokuteki since January 1, 2009. They should have sewn on the back, and centered 3 cm from the bottom of the flap, a patch with his last name and the abbreviation of the country respecting the following dimensions: 38 cm wide x 39 cm high. The name and country area must have 37 cm wide x 19.5 cm high.

The patches are the responsibility of each federation. The failure to comply with this requirement will means the disqualification from the competition.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS

It will be practiced according to the rules of WADA 2014.

COURT OF ARBITRATION

The arbitrators are required to posses the corresponding I.J.F. license, class A or B.



TRAINING CAMP

Podrán asistir los competidores del Montevideo Open 2015 hospedados en el Hotel Sede Se ofrece transporte ida y vuelta al Campo de Entrenamiento y almuerzo y cena en el Hotel Sede. It will take place from Monday March 16 to Wednesday March 18. The training timesheets for each delegation will be available when checking-in in the hotel.
