

REGISTRATION COSTS

U21, senior, Masters and Open: \$ 70 CAN (\$ 70 US)

U18: \$ 60 CAN (\$ 60 US)

E U16: \$ 50 CAN (\$ 50 US)

\$15 administrative fees will be taken for all subscription cancelation after October 26th regardless of what the reason might be.

The second registration in another division is 50% except for the Open category.

E.IGIBILITY

- 1- Be a member of a provincial judo association, of Judo Canada or of an association recognized by the IJF.
- 2-Trainers must be at least certified NCCP 1 or dojo assistant instructor formed. (Training and ethics on line)

RULES AND COMPETITION SYSTEM

- Modified double elimination system for all age division (U16, U18, U21, seniors, VI and masters).
- Tournament's software will be used for draw before the competition.
- Golden score will apply in U16, U18, U21 and senior division.
- Blue judogi is mandatory (or white-blue reversible).
- IJF tournaments rules and/or Judo Canada's will be applied.
- Arm-locks are forbidden for U16 age division.
- Athletes can only fight in one age division per day, unless they are medalists at the Canadian U16 Championship 2014.
- U16 can only fight in their own age division (they cannot fight in two divisions).

For members of Judo Quebec U16, U18, U21 and senior Quebecois competitors the Quebec Open is one of the qualification tournaments for the National Championship. Quebec Open is a tournament that gives points in Judo Canada's classification.
